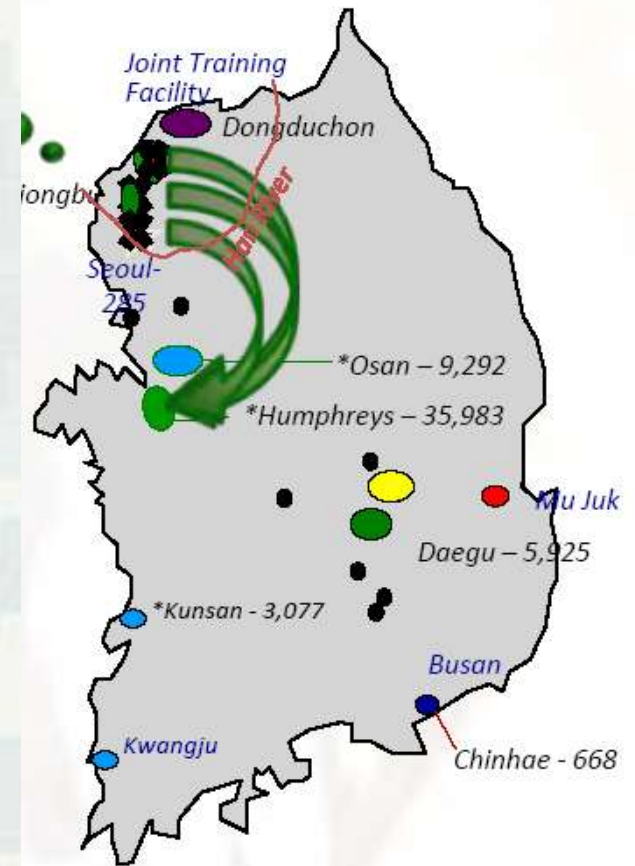


# POD - Korea Program Transformation Overview

## FY09 – FY11



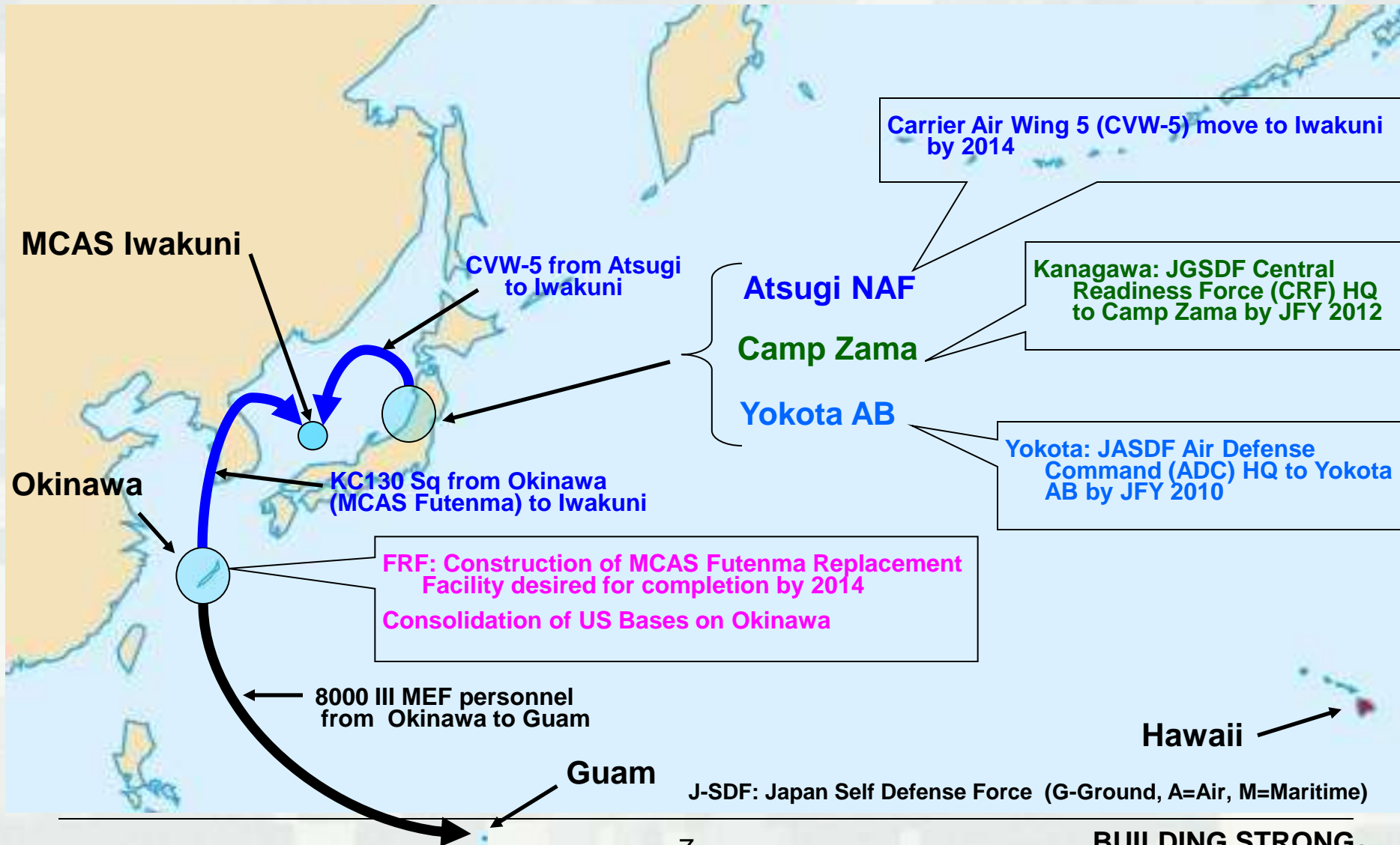

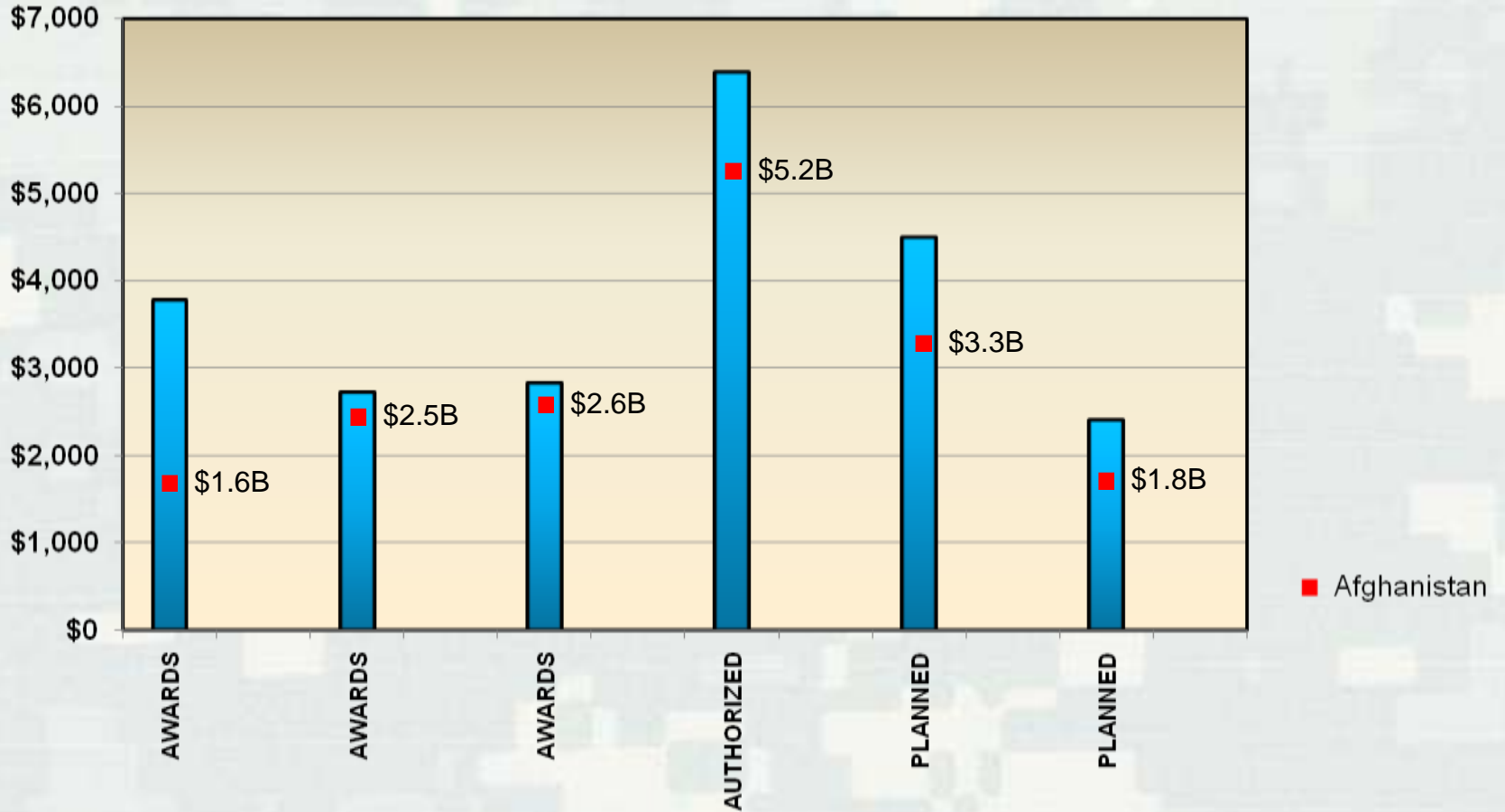

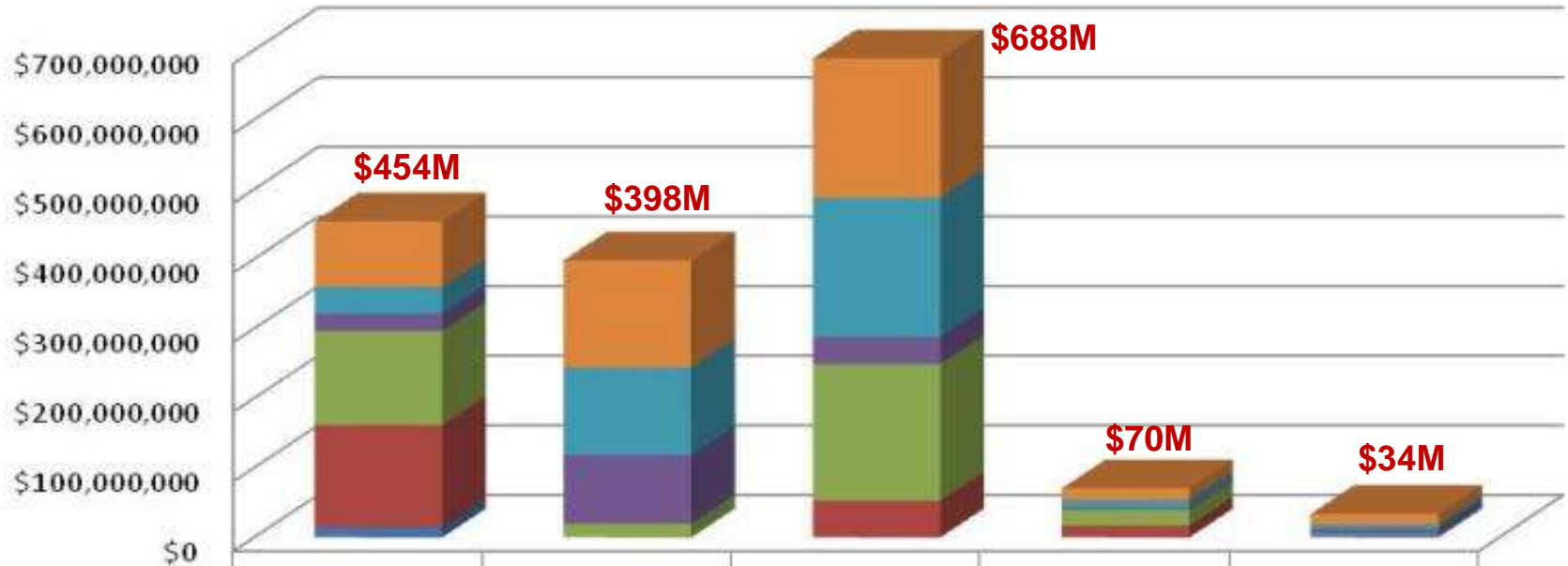

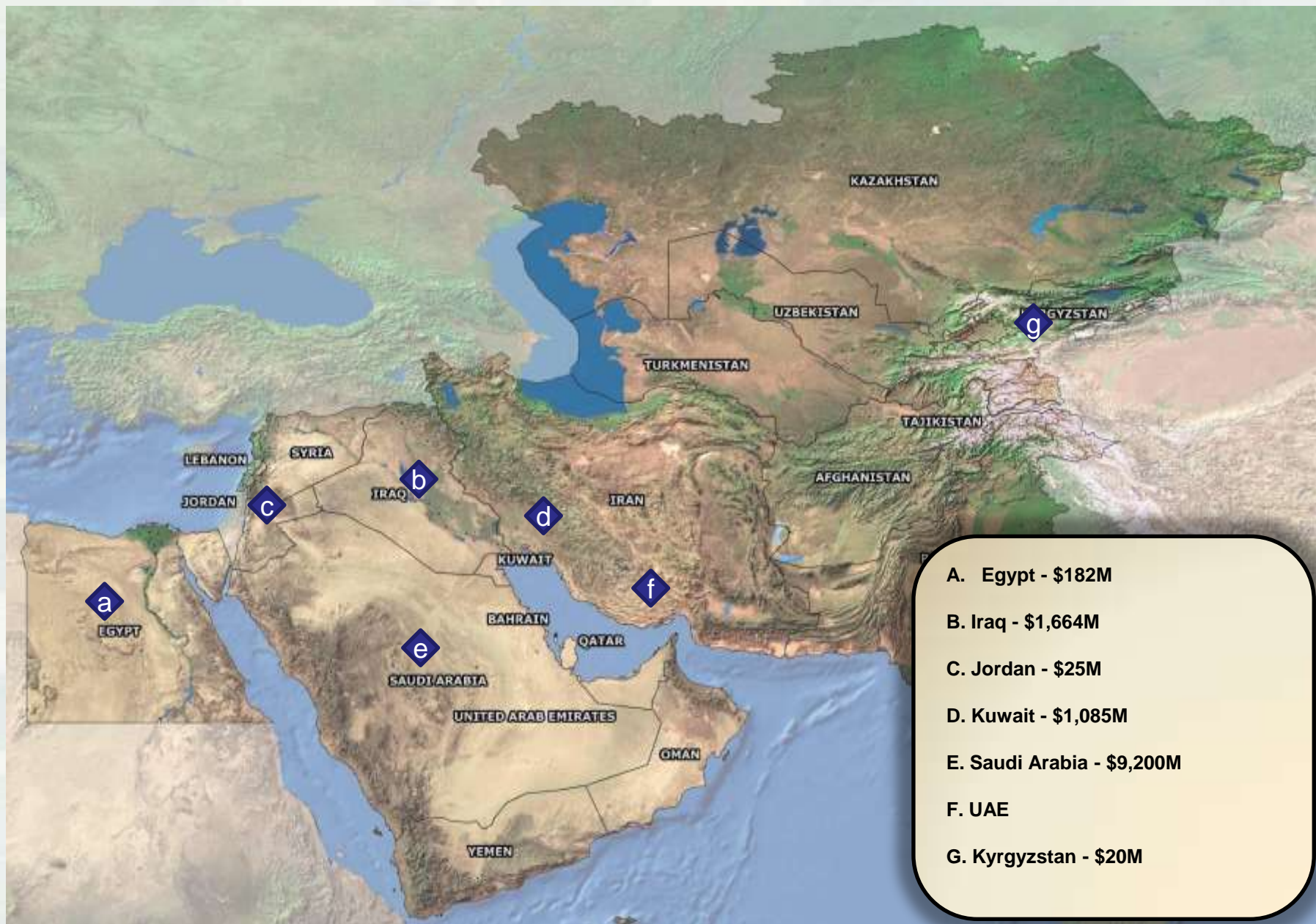

- Potential OSCI @ \$500M in FY12

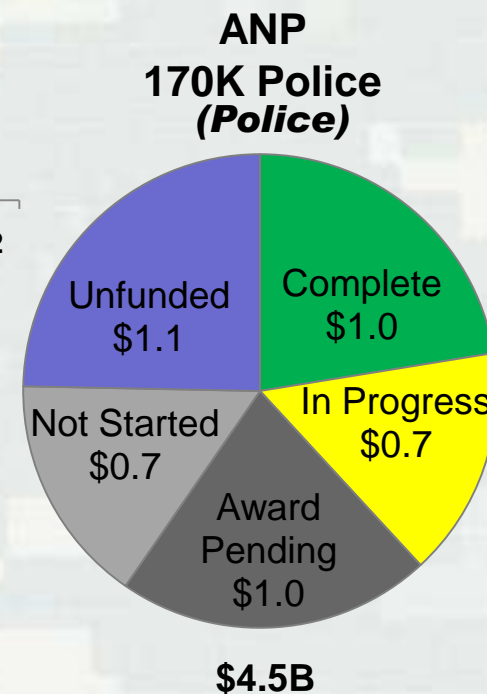
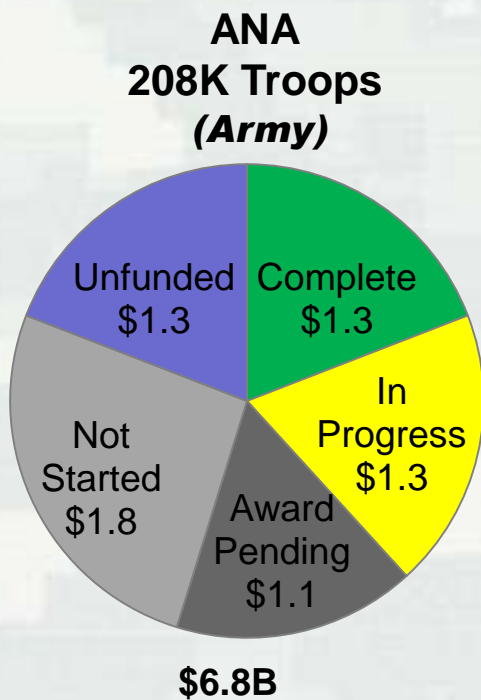
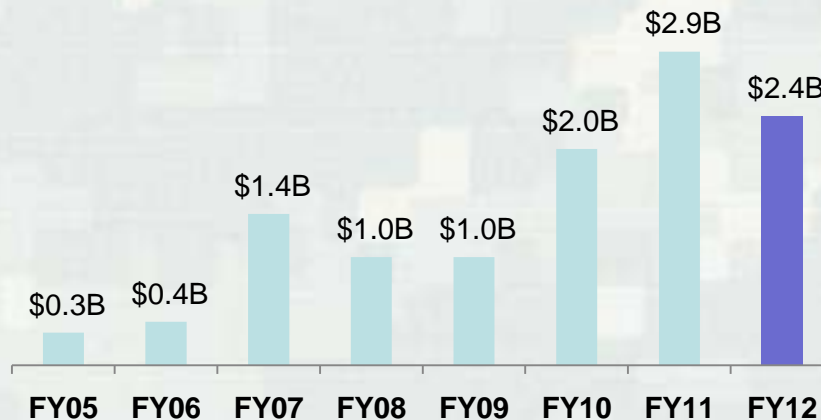

# Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) Infrastructure Program



- **Building facilities for:**
  - 300+ ANA Units - Army
  - 700+ ANP Units - Police
- **More than 250 ongoing projects valued at \$2.0 Billion**
- **Turning over one building per day**
- **GOAL → Turnover four buildings per day**

***Program Fully Funded in 2012, Pending Appropriation of President's Budget Submission***

- Studies – Band-i-Sultan Dam Safety Assessment, Amu Darya Flood Damage Reduction, Kajakai Dam, Dahla Dam, Surobi II
- River Basin Studies & Master Plans - Harirud-Murghab River, Amu Darya River, Kabul river, Helmand River
- Kandahar City Water Master Plan and Deep Well Drilling
