6. Continue to provide educational seminars at ACEC meetings.
7. Promote Professional Surveying entries at EEA.
8. Continue to lobby MOs to accept "surveying only" firms.
9. Publish at least two articles outside ACEC membership publications.

10. Monitor and propose legislation.
