According to the trend line, we are on a downslope for new cases and deaths.

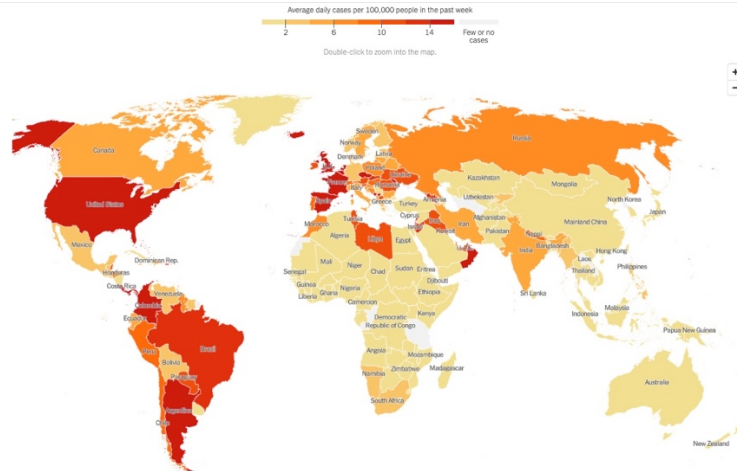
COVID-19 at a Glance in the U.S.:
